What We Accept

We welcome donations of new, unopened packages of:

- Pads (regular, overnight, maxi, thin, winged)
- Tampons (all absorbencies)
- Pantyliners
- Feminine wipes

Preferred Non-Toxic and Eco-Friendly Brands

Whenever possible, we encourage donations of body-safe, eco-friendly products. These options reduce exposure to unnecessary chemicals and are better for long-term health.

Examples include:

- Pads & Tampons: Cora, Rael, L. Organic, Seventh Generation, Natracare, Organyc
- Pantyliners: Cora, Rael, L. Organic, Natracare
- Wipes: Cora Refresh, Rael Natural Feminine Wipes, Seventh Generation Free & Clear

Do's and Don'ts

✔ Do:

- Donate only sealed, unopened packages.
- Choose non-toxic or eco-friendly products when you can.
- Collect a mix of pads, tampons, liners, and wipes—pads are always in the highest demand.

✘ Don't:

- Donate open boxes or loose products.
- Include expired or damaged items.
- Mix donations with non-period related items (such as diapers, soap, or clothing).
